Dear Valued Aerojet Rocketdyne Supplier,

Aerojet Rocketdyne (AR, including AR Coleman Aerospace) has a requirement to gather information on our suppliers' use of tantalum, tin, tungsten, or gold (collectively known as "3TG" or "conflict minerals") in all items delivered to AR and used in our products. AR has incorporated requirements for conflict minerals compliance into its purchase orders under which you delivered materials. The Conflict Minerals Policy available at: http://www.rocket.com/supp/policies requires suppliers' participation in this effort.

Your immediate action is needed to comply with the conflict minerals reporting requirements of the Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act, also known as the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act. Section 1502 requires manufacturers of products that contain 3TG to identify minerals that come from the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) or any of its adjoining countries and to file reports with the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC).

AR has contracted with a third party, **Source Intelligence**, to manage supplier engagement and the 3TG conflict minerals compliance process. **Source Intelligence will be contacting you separately.**

As a supplier identified to be within the scope of this law, it is <u>mandatory</u> that you register on the Source Intelligence web platform and provide the requested information no later than March 31, 2021. This information must be collected on an annual basis, therefore you must update your response in the system if you have previously provided information to Source Intelligence.

Please follow the steps below:

- 1. Add aerojetrocketdyne@sourceintelligence.com to your safe sender list
- 2. Open the email that will be sent to you from aerojetrocketdyne@sourceintelligence.com when it arrives
- 3. Click the registration link in the email

4. Follow the instructions to **complete the conflict minerals information request**. You may either complete a Conflict Minerals Reporting Template online or upload a CMRT, version 6.0 or higher.

As an AR supplier you have been granted a **free membership** to access the Conflict Minerals Resource Center (CMRC), a site-sponsored by seven industry associations which provides information and web-based training for suppliers and other association members. We encourage you to use this site to educate yourselves and your organization on conflict minerals compliance. You may register at http://www.conflictmineralsresources.com and use the code [SIAEROCKCUS] at the payment page for free access.
